On July 2, 2013 Governor Branstad received a Presidential Disaster Declaration designating 47 counties in Iowa. On August 8, 2013 the major disaster declaration was amended to include 2 additional counties in Iowa. This declaration initiates availability of Federal funding to assist the designated counties in recovery from major damage and debris caused by the severe storms, tornadoes and flooding that occurred during the incident period identified above.

Additional counties may yet be designated following further evaluation. Federal assistance is presently available within the counties listed below, from each respective program for which a county is designated.
