**PROCLAMATION OF SUSPENSION OF STATUTES  
DUE TO DISASTER EMERGENCY**

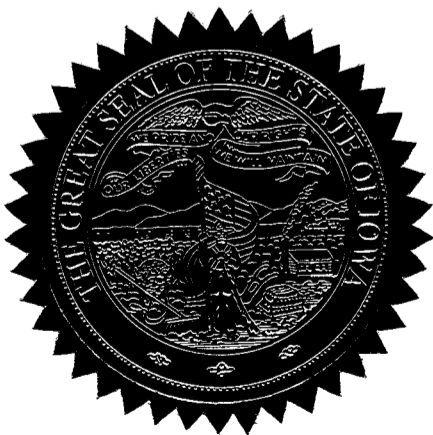
**WHEREAS,** ON SUNDAY, MAY 25, 2008 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORM SYSTEMS MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

**WHEREAS,** THESE STORM SYSTEMS SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER INCLUDING TORNADOES, HEAVY RAINS, WIND, HAIL, AND SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS, CAUSING FLOODING AND RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY INCLUDING RESIDENCES, BUSINESSES, INFRASTRUCTURE, AND AGRICULTURE; AND


**WHEREAS,** STATE-CHARTERED BANKS IN CERTAIN AREAS IMPACTED BY THE FLOODING AND SEVERE WEATHER HAVE HAD TO CLOSE OFFICES OR THEIR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS; AND

**WHEREAS,** SOME STATE-CHARTERED BANKS THAT HAVE HAD TO CLOSE OFFICES OR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS WILL NEED TO TEMPORARILY RELOCATE THOSE OFFICES OR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS UNTIL THEY CAN RETURN TO THEIR USUAL LOCATIONS.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY SUSPEND THE PROVISIONS OF IOWA CODE SUBSECTION 524.1201(1) AND THE PROVISIONS OF IOWA CODE SECTIONS 524.1501, 524.1502, AND 524.1504 IN ALL COUNTIES COVERED BY A STATE DISASTER PROCLAMATION ISSUED MAY 25, 2008 FOR 30 DAYS. THESE STATUTES ARE SUSPENDED TO THE EXTENT THEY REQUIRE STATE-CHARTERED BANKS TO RECEIVE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING PRIOR TO OPERATING A BANK OFFICE OR TO THE EXTENT THEY REQUIRE A STATE-CHARTERED BANK TO AMEND THEIR ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION TO CHANGE THEIR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS WHERE NECESSARY TO PERMIT THE BANK TO OPERATE OUT OF A TEMPORARY LOCATION. STATE-CHARTERED BANKS OPERATING OUT OF TEMPORARY LOCATIONS SHALL NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING OF THEIR TEMPORARY LOCATIONS AND WHEN THEY RETURN TO THEIR USUAL LOCATIONS.**
