**PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AMENDED EXTENSION**

**WHEREAS,** ON SUNDAY MAY 25, 2008 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORM SYSTEMS MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

**WHEREAS,** THESE STORM SYSTEMS SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER INCLUDING TORNADOS, HIGH WINDS, HAIL, AND HEAVY RAINS AND RESULTED IN WIDESPREAD FLOODING AND DESTRUCTION ACROSS MANY IOWA COUNTIES; AND

**WHEREAS,** SEVERAL STATE-CHARTERED BANKS IN THESE COUNTIES HAVE BEEN FLOODED OR DAMAGED AND HAVE HAD TO CLOSE OFFICES OR THEIR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS; AND

**WHEREAS,** SOME STATE-CHARTERED BANKS THAT HAVE HAD TO CLOSE OFFICES OR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS WILL NEED TO TEMPORARILY RELOCATE THOSE OFFICES OR PRINCIPAL PLACES OF BUSINESS UNTIL THEY CAN RETURN TO THEIR USUAL LOCATIONS; AND

**WHEREAS,** STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH STATE STATUTES WHICH LIMIT THE ABILITY OF A STATE-CHARTERED BANK TO OPERATE AT A NEW LOCATION WOULD DELAY A STATE-CHARTERED BANK'S ABILITY TO PROVIDE NEEDED FINANCIAL SERVICES TO ITS CUSTOMERS OUT OF TEMPORARY ALTERNATIVE LOCATIONS; AND

**WHEREAS,** AVAILABILITY OF FINANCIAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY STATE-CHARTERED BANKS IS NECESSARY TO HELP CITIZENS OF AFFECTED COMMUNITIES COPE WITH THE EMERGENCY PRESENTED BY SAID STORMS.


**NOW THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, BY THE POWER VESTED IN ME BY THE CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE IV, SECTIONS 1 AND 8 AND IOWA CODE SECTION 29C.6(1), DO HEREBY DECLARE THE FOLLOWING:**

1. PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE SECTION 29C.6(6), I DO HEREBY SUSPEND THE PROVISIONS OF IOWA CODE SUBSECTION 524.1201(1) REQUIRING STATE-CHARTERED BANKS TO OBTAIN THE APPROVAL OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING TO OPERATE A BANK OFFICE OUT OF A NEW LOCATION, AS APPLIED TO ANY STATE-CHARTERED BANK IN ANY ONE OF THE DISASTER COUNTIES THAT WAS FORCED TO CLOSE AND RELOCATE AN OFFICE AS A RESULT OF SAID STORMS. STATE-CHARTERED BANKS OPERATING OUT OF TEMPORARY LOCATIONS SHALL NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING OF THEIR TEMPORARY LOCATIONS TO INVOKE THE SUSPENSION AND NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING WHEN THEY RETURN TO THEIR USUAL LOCATIONS.
2. PURSUANT TO IOWA CODE SECTION 29C.6(6), I DO HEREBY SUSPEND THE PROVISIONS OF IOWA CODE SECTIONS 524.1501, 524.1502, AND 524.1504 REQUIRING STATE-CHARTERED BANKS TO OBTAIN PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING AND TO AMEND THEIR ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION TO CHANGE THEIR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS, AS APPLIED TO ANY STATE-CHARTERED BANK IN ANY ONE OF THE DISASTER COUNTIES THAT WAS FORCED TO CLOSE AND RELOCATE ITS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AS A RESULT OF SAID STORMS. STATE-CHARTERED BANKS OPERATING OUT OF TEMPORARY LOCATIONS SHALL NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING OF THEIR TEMPORARY LOCATIONS TO INVOKE THE SUSPENSION AND NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF BANKING WHEN THEY RETURN TO THEIR USUAL LOCATIONS.



3. THIS EMERGENCY DECLARATION IS AN EXTENSION OF A DECLARATION ISSUED ON MAY 25, 2008. THE EXTENSION IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT THROUGH THE PERIOD OF TIME THAT DISASTER DECLARATIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR THE IMPACTED COUNTIES.
