
PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS,** ON THURSDAY MARCH 26, 2009 A FIRE IN THE ELECTRIC SUBSTATION CAUSED A POWER OUTAGE IN THE CITY OF CHURDAN IN GREENE COUNTY; AND
- WHEREAS,** THE LOSS OF POWER RESULTED IN THE INABILITY TO PUMP WATER INTO THE CITY WATER TOWER CAUSING A SHORTAGE OF WATER FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION AND TO MEET OTHER LIFE SUSTAINING REQUIREMENTS; AND
- WHEREAS,** THE CITY OF CHURDAN AND GREENE COUNTY, AFTER EXHAUSTING MUTUAL AID, HAVE REQUESTED POWER GENERATING CAPABILITIES FROM THE STATE OF IOWA THAT MAY BE PROVIDED BY THE IOWA NATIONAL GUARD; AND
- WHEREAS,** THIS PROCLAMATION SERVES TO AUTHORIZE THE NATIONAL GUARD TO PROVIDE POWER GENERATION RESOURCES AND SUPPORT:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR GREENE COUNTY IN THE STATE OF IOWA, FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST GREENE COUNTY IN THIS TIME OF NEED. THIS PROCLAMATION DOES NOT MAKE AVAILABLE THE RESOURCES OF THE STATE INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AS PROVIDED IN IOWA CODE 29C.20A.
