
PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

- WHEREAS,** ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 19, 2010, A SEVERE WINTER STORM MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND
- WHEREAS,** THIS STORM SYSTEM PRODUCED FREEZING RAIN WHICH CAUSED HEAVY ICE ACCUMULATIONS, RESULTING IN PROLONGED POWER OUTAGES AND RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE; AND
- WHEREAS,** LOCAL OFFICIALS IMPACTED BY THE SEVERE WEATHER NEED ASSISTANCE WITH EMERGENCY POWER GENERATION, DEBRIS REMOVAL AND OTHER RESULTING IMPACTS; AND
- WHEREAS,** ON JANUARY 21, 2010 I ISSUED MY PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER FOR AUDUBON, CALHOUN, CARROLL, CASS, CRAWFORD AND SAC COUNTIES; AND
- WHEREAS,** STATE ASSISTANCE WILL CONTINUE TO BE NEEDED IN CALHOUN, CARROLL AND SAC COUNTIES TO MINIMIZE THE HARDSHIP AND RECOVER FROM THE IMPACTS OF THIS STORM.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY TO BE EXTENDED FOR THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES: CALHOUN, CARROLL, AND SAC UNTIL MARCH 22, 2010. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT TO RENDER GOODS AND SUFFICIENT AID TO ASSIST THOSE AREAS IN THIS TIME OF NEED.


