

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF IOWA

PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, ON FRIDAY, JULY 30, 2010 AND CONTINUING, SEVERE STORM SYSTEMS

MOVED ACROSS PORTIONS OF IOWA; AND

WHEREAS, THESE STORM SYSTEMS SPAWNED SEVERE WEATHER TO INCLUDE

FLOODING, FLASH FLOODING AND RELATED IMPACTS TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY INCLUDING RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES; AND

PUBLIC PROPERTY INCLUDING RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES, AND

WHEREAS, LOCAL OFFICIALS AND RESIDENTS IMPACTED BY THIS SEVERE WEATHER

NEED ASSISTANCE TO DEAL WITH THE IMPACTS OF THESE STORMS; AND

WHEREAS, SURVEYS AND REPORTS FORWARDED BY LOCAL OFFICIALS IN APPANOOSE,

JOHNSON AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES INDICATE THAT STATE

ASSISTANCE WILL BE NEEDED TO RESPOND TO AND RECOVER FROM THE

EFFECTS OF THESE STORMS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHESTER J. CULVER, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF IOWA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM A STATE OF DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR APPANOOSE, JOHNSON AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES IN THE STATE OF IOWA, FOR THE AFOREMENTIONED REASONS. THIS PROCLAMATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY AUTHORIZES THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATE INDIVIDUAL ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TO ASSIST ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS AND MINIMIZE THEIR HARDSHIP.
